Sno-Park: (Ira) Reported on phone call with Jason regarding his attempt to secure funding from the County to aid in possible construction of a cell tower on park property - county funds not available, private funding an option. There was one inquiry to KPRD via website regarding summer usage of Sno-Park. The chain Ira installed is serving its purpose per site visit by Ira and Ali.

Roslyn RIdge / "Rat-Pack" Trail: (Keegan) Stated she is still working with the parties involved to fine-tune language in the permit relating to responsibilities and liabilities.

UKCCRCA: (Kent) The alliance is still exploring with the county the concept of a Public Utilities district.

No other projects were briefed.
New Business: (Ira) The County Bocc asked for a briefing on KPRD1 while Ali and Ira were requesting relief from certain election costs at a recent BoCC meeting.
